Croydon Shire Council will commence fogging for mosquitos. Fogging will be ongoing until mosquitos are under control.

The most effective way to reduce your chance of being bitten by mosquitoes is to protect yourself:

- Avoid going outside when mosquitoes are most active, around dusk and dawn
- If going outside at these times, wear loose clothing and cover exposed skin
- Use an insect repellent
- · Screen doors and windows to stop mosquitoes from getting inside
- Empty pot plant saucers, pet bowls, birdbaths and other containers that hold water at least once a week, wipe the inside out with a cloth to remove any mosquito eggs
- · Dispose of any items lying around outside that may hold water
- Empty wading pools after use and clean thoroughly
- Ensure roof guttering is in good condition, remove leaves so pools of water don't form and cut back overhanging trees to prevent blockages from leaves and debris
- · Ensure all rainwater tank openings have mosquito proof screens.
